ACBG Brasil is a private, non-profit civil society organization that works for the benefit of patients with head and neck cancer and their families throughout Brazil. Founded in 2015 with the mission to give voice to those who don't have one and with the long-term vision to reduce the mortality of patients and improve the quality of life for those with head and neck cancer, ACBG Brasil is a national reference in advocacy, inclusion, and information.

Impact:

- Inclusion of the electronic larynx in the SUS (Unified Health System) budget list;
- Correction of the value of the tracheoesophageal prosthesis in the SUS budget list;
- Co-production of a public policy for the health care of tracheostomized and/or laryngectomized individuals in Santa Catarina;
- Approval of legislation to designate July as the National Month for Head and Neck Cancer Prevention;
- Approval of legislation to designate August 11 as the National Day of the Laryngectomized;
- Creation of Rede+Voz, the largest advocacy and social control network in oncology in the country;
- Creation of the National Campaign for Head and Neck Cancer Prevention (#JulhoVerde - Green July).

Politize! is a civil society organization with a mission to educate and empower a generation of conscious and engaged citizens committed to democracy. To achieve this, we provide political education to anyone, anywhere, always respecting the plurality of ideas, beliefs, and positions.

- 3,400 pieces of content have been published since 2015;
- 1.5~2 million users access our website every month;
